

Blue Ribbon Certificate of Achievement - Score Sheet Guidelines

Clubs: complete form and submit as email attachment to YOUR District Director by **December 1** (of the awards year).

District Directors: submit **LIST** of eligible clubs to CGCI Awards Co-Chairman by **January 10**. (Do NOT send score sheets)

The Blue Ribbon Certificate of Achievement is awarded to clubs earning 100 points of a possible 200 points on the attached score sheet.

- No proof of achievement is required.
- The form has been revised for 2015-17 to eliminate some outdated items, add new ones and increase a few of the points available.
- To complete the form:
 - Save the form to a folder on your computer
 - Open from your computer and complete
 - Type in name of club
 - Tab to each applicable "score" line and type in the points scored
 - The total is automatically calculated at bottom
 - SAVE the form
 - Email as an attachment to YOUR District Director

Scoring guidelines:

- Give yourself at least ONE point for any partial participation/support.
- CGCI President's Project: If you donate money to the project **or** actively participate in the actual project you receive full points.
- Contributions to state projects: Monetary donations to ANY of CGCI's several projects, scholarship, endowment or honor book receive full points.
- NGC Schools:
 - Attendance: if one or more members attend any of the schools, you get the points; they do not have to pass the tests to become judges or consultants.
 - Credentials: if one or more of your members is a credentialed judge or consultant you get the appropriate points listed.
- Youth: Whether you financially sponsor - Youth Projects or are actively involved in Youth Clubs/Groups, you earn full points. No double counting, if you counted donation to CGCI's President Project.
