2. Pages (1 pt.) Not crowded with attractive spacing, legible printing and drawing. Maximum of ten (10) sheets, 20 sides, 8 ½" x 11" using clear plastic page protectors with pages numbered; no handwritten text; no decorative art work; not crowded	1.0	_____
3. Contents (21.25 pts.), as follows:		
a. Title page .75 pt. Award # and name; sponsoring organization with city and state; applicant contact name (president, director, etc.) with address, telephone number, email address		
b. Table of Contents (.5) pt.		
c. Show Description (3 pts.) 300 words or less. Text includes: title, size, scope, type of show, theme, division staging and special features.		
d. Show Data (2.5 pts.) Information must appear in body of application as well as on application form.		
1) List of sponsoring organization		
2) Number of club members in Club or organization (.25 pt.)		
3) Number of participating Club members or, if council, district or state organization., number of participating garden clubs (.25 pt.)		
4) Percentage of participating Club members or garden clubs (.5 pt.)		
5) Total number of exhibits in: (.75 pt.) Horticulture____, Design____, Special Exhibits____		
6) List of Top Exhibitor Awards offered, note if not given (.50 pt.) Horticulture____, Design____, Special Exhibits____		
7) Source of Flower Show funding (.25 pt.)		

e. Photographs (4 pts.)

Need not be professional pictures. Omit people if possible.

1) Top Exhibitor Award Winners in all Divisions (1 pt.)

2) Each picture labeled with Division, Section, Class, award & brief description. (3 pts.)

f. Staging (4 pts.)

Theme staging & actual staging with overall views within each Division; also staging of individual Sections in all Divisions.

g. Publicity (1 pt.)

Newspaper & other publications with name and date of publication.

Scripts or schedules from radio/TV broadcasts, flyers, etc.

Scripts or schedules from radio/TV broadcasts, flyers and pictures of poster displays in public buildings are also acceptable.

h. Schedule (4 pts.) as follows:

1) Include 1 schedule in envelope in inside back cover. (1 pt.)

2) Correctness of text and all necessary inclusions. (3 pts.)

i. Conformance (1.5 pts.)

DETERMINATION OF FINAL SCORE FOR THE FLOWER SHOW.

A. Average and converted Judges' evaluation score (see below) is combined with Book of Evidence score for a possible total of 100 pts.

B. The three Flower Show Judges' evaluations must average 90 or higher to be considered for a California Flower Show Achievement Award. These average scores, when converted to 75% of the final score, become the following:

- Average Score of 94.66 is converted to 75 points of final score.
- Average Score of 94.33 is converted to 74.75 points of final score.
- Average Score of 94.0 is converted to 74.5 points of final score.
- Average Score of 93.66 is converted to 74.25 points of final score.
- Average Score of 93.33 is converted to 74.0 points of final score.
- Average Score of 93.0 is converted to 73.75 points of final score.
- Average Score of 92.66 is converted to 73.5 points of final score.
- Average Score of 92.33 is converted to 73.25 points of final score.
- Average Score of 92.0 is converted to 73.0 points of final score.
- Average Score of 91.66 is converted to 72.75 points of final score.
- Average Score of 91.33 is converted to 72.5 points of final score.
- Average Score of 91.0 is converted to 72.25 points of final score.
- Average Score of 90.66 is converted to 72.0 points of final score.
- Average Score of 90.33 is converted to 71.75 points of final score.
- Average Score of 90.0 is converted to 71.5 points of final score.

Average score of less than 90 is not eligible for award consideration. Maximum score of Book of Evidence is 25 points.
