In order to maintain accreditation, judges/consultants are required to attend refresher events that enhance knowledge acquired, explore current trends, and promote interest in the school subject. Consultants of Environmental, Gardening, and Landscape Design Schools are encouraged to refresh in refresher events sponsored within the organization. A multiple refresher may be for two (Bi-Refresher) or three (Tri-Refresher) of these schools where subject matter oftentimes overlaps to a large degree. Flower Show School courses/symposia usually concentrate on flower shows, horticulture and design.

Educational opportunities provided by National Garden Clubs:

Environmental School – designed to train students to appreciate the natural resources of our Earth

Flower Show School – designed to accredit judges for Standard Flower Shows

Gardening School – designed to stimulate interest in many facets of gardening practices

Landscape Design School – designed to train students to recognize good land use

Consultants may refresh once per calendar year and must refresh by the end of the fifth calendar year after becoming a Consultant or last refreshing.
