Accredited Judge - Submit form 13E. Accredited Judge two years from the date of accreditation or last renewal, providing the proper number of exhibiting and judging credits has been obtained.

Life & Master Judges - Submit form 15E with completed necessary documentation.

Judges From Other States - a Judge who wishes to attend a symposium from another state must forward a completed application to their home State FSS Chairman or Credentials Chairman before registering for the Symposium for credit. All judges are welcome to attend.

IMPORTANT: ALL Judges taking the Point Scoring Exam will be seated in the front rows. Please bring clipboard and pencils for the exam.
