

STAGECOACH HILL ANNUAL REPORT 2017

Donations have been received to promote the work in the Stagecoach Hill Azalea Reserve located north of Trinidad in Humboldt County. In addition to the propagation project, the signs have been repainted and California State Parks arranged to have extensive removal of the invasive plants such as alder trees, ferns, non native grasses and berry vines. The American Rhododendron Society brought 150 tourists to the reserve and private tours were provided by California Garden Clubs, Inc .members. Newspaper articles and new pamphlets have increased the public awareness of this native western azalea (Rhododendron Occidentale)
