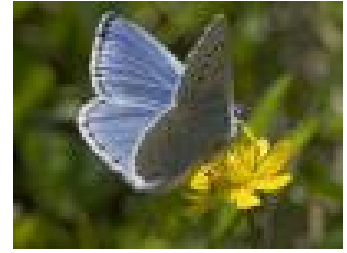




## PROJECT MISSION BLUE
