Milagra Ridge Driving Directions with Google map: Directions to Milagra Ridge from Interstate 280: Get onto I-280 on the San Francisco peninsula between the towns of Daly City and San Bruno. Look for the Westborough Boulevard exit (west), which lies about 4.5 miles south of the Daly City BART station. (The Westborough exit is about 1.5 miles north of the I-380 junction that comes over to I-280 from San Francisco International Airport). Take the Westborough Blvd. exit and go west on Westborough 1 mile to Skyline Blvd. Cross Skyline Blvd. going straight (Westborough becomes Sharp Park Blvd.) Go west 0.6 miles on Sharp Park Blvd. to its intersection with College Drive. Look for a National Parks Service sign (brown and tan color) to Milagra Ridge. Turn right and follow the road into the Spyglass Hill subdivision to a dead end where there is a gate. Your tour guide will meet you at the gate.
